The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on May 14, 2002 to canvass the Remsen-Union Special Election held on May 7, 2002 with all members present.

Upon the public measure *“Shall the Board of Directors of the Remsen-Union Community School District in the counties of Plymouth and Sioux, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$5,500,000 to provide funds to build and furnish new elementary and new middle school buildings, and to improve and acquire sites?”*

There were one thousand six hundred ten (1610) votes cast as follows:

FOR the question there were nine hundred sixty one (961) votes cast.

AGAINST the question there were six hundred forty-nine(649) votes cast.

We therefore declare the public measure “see above” to be not adopted.
