The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on November 13, 2003 at 4:00 p.m.. All members were present. All votes are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Minutes of the November 10, 2003 meeting were approved.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Spies, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from agricultural to agricultural rural residential for Daniel Britt on 3.12 acres in Sec. 22 Stanton Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Greene, seconded by Philips, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from agricultural to agricultural rural residential for Margaret Healy Estate on 5 acres in Sec. 13 Meadow Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Greene, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from agricultural to agricultural rural residential for Roger Guntren on 1.47 acres in Sec.1 Marion Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Philips, to approve the zoning boards recommendation of a change from agricultural to commercial for Roger Guntren in Sec. 1 Marion Township on 3.39 acres subject to obtaining a conditional use permit. Motion carried.

Motion by Vander Hamm , seconded by Philips, to approve Guntren Minor Subdivision in Sec. 1 Marion Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Vander Hamm, seconded by Philips, to approve a grant application for vehicle acquisition for 2 vehicles for \$1.00 each through local emergency management with the Board Chairman authorized to sign. Motion carried.

Motion by Greene, seconded by Spies, to approve a contract amendment for reducing the health nurse's and home care aide state allocation. Motion carried.

Motion by Philips, seconded by Greene, to accept the bid of Roder Construction for snow removal at the jail/communication center at \$85.00/hour for the payloader or \$65.00/hour for a skidloader. Motion carried.

Craig Bartolozzi asked if the Board would consider a first responder team with some training in First Aid for the Courthouse.

Motion by Spies, seconded by Greene, to approve Resolution #111303 naming bank depositories for Plymouth County. Greene-aye; Spies-aye; Vander Hamm-aye; Philips-aye; Sitzmann-aye. Motion carried.
