The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on April 29, 2008 at 9:30 a.m. Present was Chairman Schneider, members Anderson, Kass and Greene. Member Henrich was absent. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

The agenda for the April 29, 2008 meeting was approved.

Minutes of the April 22, 2008 meeting were approved.

The Board discussed changes to the L.O.S.T. grant application for 2009-2010 recommended by the L.O.S.T. Advisory Board. The Board would like the ballot question that includes the property tax relief wording to be included in the cover letter of the grant application.

Shawn Olson, Plymouth County IT Director, gave a presentation of the new County website and the GIS website.

Deb Steffen, Plymouth County Public Health Manager, presented the 2007-2008 Iowa Dept. of Public Health Alternative Plan.

Motion by Greene, seconded by Kass, to approve the Alternative Plan Contract Revision for 2007-2008 with the IDPH. Motion Carried.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve the request to modify and to add the area of technology revision to the 2007-2008 IDPH plan for \$2,000. Motion Carried.

Motion by Greene, seconded by Kass, to change the contractor from Plymouth County Board of Supervisors to the Plymouth County Board of Public Health as the local Public Health Service contractor. Kass-aye; Greene-aye, Anderson-nay; Schneider-aye Motion Carried.

Sharon Nieman, Plymouth County CPC & General Relief Director, presented the FY08-09 Target Case Management contract.

Motion by Greene, seconded by Kass, to approve the lease agreement contract with the State of Iowa for the Target Case Management unit. Motion Carried.

Tom Rohe, Plymouth County Engineer and Jim Lane from the NRCS presented the Little Sioux funding for grade control and Project #LC-041908 for Plymouth County.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve the NRCS contract to assist in funding county project #LC-041908. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Greene, to approve two permits for Little Sioux Rural Water in Sec 5/6 of Washington Twp and Sec 14/23 of Liberty Twp. Motion Carried.
