The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom to canvass the school election that was held on September 9, 2008. Present was Chairman Schneider, members Kass and Anderson. Absent was members Greene and Henrich.

Motion by Kass, seconded by Anderson, to approve the canvass of the School Board Election as presented:

AKRON-WESTFIELD

For the office of Director District 5 there were twenty-five (25) votes cast as follows: Joyce Toben received thirteen (13) votes; Janet Willer received five (5) votes; scattering received seven (7) votes. We therefore declare Joyce Toben duly elected for the office of Director District 5 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 6 there were seventy-three (73) votes cast as follows: Debra Jordt received seventy (70) votes; scattering received three (3) votes. We therefore declare Debra Jordt duly elected for the office of Director District 6 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director At Large there were seventy-four (74) votes cast as follows: Roger Oetken received seventy-four (74) votes. We therefore declare Roger Oetken duly elected for the office of Director At Large for the term of 3 years.

HINTON COMMUNITY

For the office of Director At Large there were four hundred sixty-six (466) votes cast as follows: Rich Kallsen received thirty-eight (38) votes; John W. Reintzel received seventy-six (76) votes; Randy Riediger received one hundred thirty (130) votes; Ed Vondrak received one hundred thirty-one (131) votes; Melissa J. Willer received ninety (90) votes; scattering received one (1) vote. We therefore declare Randy Riediger duly elected for the office of Director At Large for the term of 3 years and Ed Vondrak duly elected for the office of Director At Large for the term of 3 years.

KINGSLEY-PIERSON

For the office of Director District 2 there were two hundred seventy-seven (277) votes cast as follows: Amy Hill received thirty-eight (38) votes; Clayton Powell received one hundred sixty-three (163) votes; Tim Reis received seventy-five (75) votes; scattering received one (1) vote. We therefore declare Clayton Powell duly elected for the office of Director District 2 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 4 there were two hundred seventy-three (273) votes cast as follows: Bobbi Hirschman received two hundred thirty-three (233) votes; Jerrod C. Olson received thirty-six (36) votes; scattering received four (4) votes. We therefore declare Bobbi Hirschman duly elected for the office of Director District 4 for the term of 3 years.

LEMARS COMMUNITY

For the office of Director District 3 there were five hundred eighty-one (581) votes cast as follows: Mark Hemmingson received four hundred forty-two (442) votes; scattering received one hundred thirty-nine (139) votes. We therefore declare Mark Hemmingson duly elected for the office of Director District 3 for the term of 3 years.

For the office of Director District 5 there were three thousand three hundred nineteen (3319) votes cast as follows: Joe E. Cain received one thousand sixty-nine (1069) votes; Dan Smith received two thousand two hundred twenty-one (2221) votes; scattering received twenty-nine (29) votes. We therefore declare Dan Smith duly elected for the office of Director District 5 for the term of 3 years.

PROPOSITION C

Upon public measure "Shall the Board of Directors of the Le Mars Community School District in the county of Plymouth, State of Iowa, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years to levy and impose an instructional support tax in an amount after taking into consideration instructional support state aid, not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the total of regular program district costs for the budget year and monies received under Section 257.14, as a budget adjustment in the budget year, and be authorized annually in combination as determined by the Board, to levy an instructional support property tax upon all taxable property within the school district, commencing with the levy for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, and to impose an instructional support income surtax upon the state individual income tax of each individual income taxpayer resident in the school district on December 31 for each calendar year commencing with calendar year 2009, or each year thereafter, the percent of income surtax to be determined by the Board for each fiscal year to be used for any general fund purpose?"

There were three thousand eight hundred seventeen (3817) votes cast as follows:

FOR the question, there were one thousand eight hundred eighty-two (1882) votes.

AGAINST the question, there were one thousand nine hundred thirty-five (1935) votes.

We therefore declare the public measure C not to be adopted.

REMSEN-UNION

For the office of Director District 2 there were ten (10) votes cast as follows: Arlie Pick received ten (10) votes. We therefore declare Arlie Pick duly elected for the office of Director District 2 for the term of 3 years.

WESTERN IOWA TECH COMMUNITY COLLEGE

For the office of Western Iowa Tech Community College Director there were one hundred fifty-three (153) votes cast as follows: Curt Grigg received one hundred twelve (112) votes; John P. VanEldik received forty-one (41) votes.
