The Plymouth County Board of Supervisors met in the Boardroom on August 25, 2009 at 9:30 a.m. All members were present. All votes following are aye unless otherwise indicated.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Greene, to approve the August 18, 2009 minutes. Anderson abstained. Motion Carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Loutsch, to declare a metal mail cabinet as County surplus property. Motion Carried.

Bill Koopman, Plymouth County resident was present to discuss the changing of the county road name from Keystone Avenue to Key Ave. The concerns he noted were the process and manner that residents that live along Keystone were notified by the 911 Board and the potential costs that are associated with this change for the 20 residents that it affects.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Kass, to approve a tile permit for Section 5/8 and 4/5 of Henry Township. Motion Carried.

Motion by Greene, to accept a contract for M+ Architect for \$37,900 for the courthouse annex building. Motion died for lack of a second.

Motion by Loutsch, seconded by Greene, to approve a contract for M+ Architect for \$36,400 for the courthouse annex building. Loutsch-nay; Kass-nay; Anderson-aye; Greene-aye; Henrich-aye. Motion Carried.
